



Cheltenham District Scout and Explorer Scout GIS and DTM Have a go session

On the **Thursday 5th March 2009, from 6pm to 8pm**, there will be a chance for Scouts and Explorer Scouts to have a go at using Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and Digital Terrain Modelling to see how maps and images can be used to find out about an area. We aim to include looking at contours and how they can be used to indicate the terrain. The University of Gloucestershire has kindly agreed to allow us to use their equipment and facilities. Uniformed Adults may also attend but you may have to share a computer with a Scout or Explorer. There will be a maximum of 30 Scouts or Explorers allowed with no more than 10 Adults. If this is popular or the day is not suitable we will try to run the event again.

You will be met in the Campus' St Pauls Road Car Park. All people who are attending this event must be in Uniform so that you can be easily identified by security. Collection will be from the Campus Refectory near the Car Park.
